

What is Computerized Radiography?

Computerized Radiography is one of the fastest growing modalities in the imaging industry! It combines a Diagnostic Radiology (X-RAY) machine with a powerful computer to produce digital x-ray images instead of analog images. Your digital x-ray images no longer require x-ray film but may be viewed or transmitted electronically to any monitor or computer with high speed connectivity.

Why is this test done?

First, your physician orders a routine x-ray of any kind. Sheridan Radiology then performs the routine x-ray after which we digitize the images.

How do I prepare for this test?
